Celebrate MLK Weekend 2017 with *Out of the Shadows*, a concert honoring the work of African-American artists and activists, and featuring the world premiere of One Voice's largest commission ever, *The Man Behind the Dream*, a new choral work by Cincinnati composer Steve Milloy. This commission honors the life and work of openly gay civil rights activist Bayard Rustin, a mentor to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and organizer of the 1963 March on Washington, who was pushed to the margins of the movement due to his sexuality. *The Man Behind the Dream* is a multi-movement piece set for chorus, spoken word, soloists and band, and is narrated by incomparable Twin Cities' singer and actor, T. Mychael Rambo.

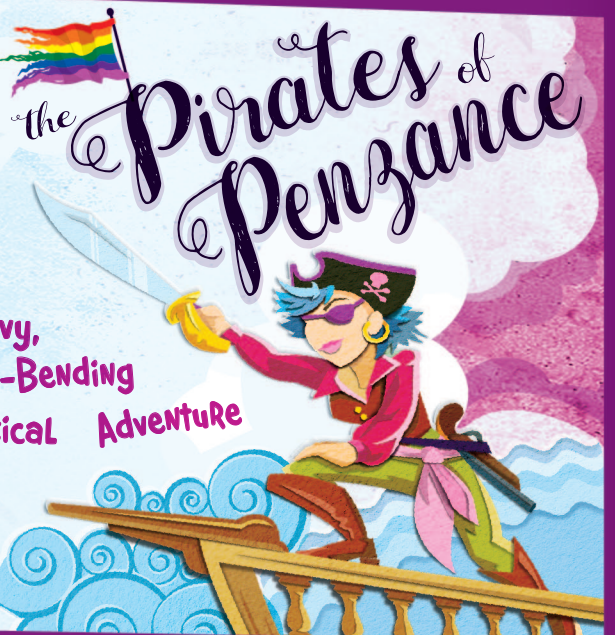
